- Introduction of professional electives to enable students to delve into specific areas of expertise or subjects that align with their professional aspirations.
- Embracing Indian Knowledge Systems through Non-Credit Courses in alignment with guidelines of University Grants Commission.
- Introduction of semester-long industry internship in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semesters as part of the Scheme 2.
- Introduction of semester/year-long startup scheme to provide credit to students who engage in meaningful entrepreneurial pursuits leading to establishing a startup venture as part of the scheme 2.

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 To recommend changes in the existing curriculum of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester - ECE & EE Programs.

The committee members were apprised about the changes recommended in the existing curriculum of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester - ECE & EE Programs. These changes were made in response to feedback from both students and faculty, aiming to streamline the operational aspects of the timetable and course delivery. The following changes were recommended to Academic Council for approval by the Board Studies:

### **Changes proposed in the curriculum of ECE Program:**

- 1-credit is proposed to be reduced from Introduction to C programming in the 1st semester and will be integrated into the Indian Constitution course that has been upgraded from a non-credit course to a one-credit course.
- The 1-credit Technical Communication Lab in the second semester is proposed to be withdrawn. Instead, the credit previously allocated to the lab will be integrated into the Technical Communication course, resulting in an enhancement to its credit value from 3 credits to 4 credits.

### Changes proposed in the curriculum of EE Program:

- 1-credit is proposed to be reduced from Introduction to C programming in the 1st semester and will be integrated into the Indian Constitution course that has been upgraded from a non-credit course to a one-credit course.
- The 2-credit Technical Communication Lab in the second semester is proposed to be withdrawn. Instead, the credit previously allocated to the lab will be integrated into the Technical Communication course, resulting in an enhancement to its credit value from 3 credits to 5 credits.
