The members were apprised of the changes recommended in the existing curriculum of the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> semesters of the BBA LLB (Hons.) program for 2023-28 batch and beyond in line with the BCI Circular (BCID-0468-2024) dated May 20, 2024, and the new laws: Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam, 2023, starting from the 2024-2025 academic year. The following changes were recommended to the Academic Council.

- a. The course "Law of Crimes-I" in the 3rd semester has been replaced with "Law of Crimes BNS 2023".
- b. The course "Law of Crimes-II" in the 4th semester has been replaced with "Law of Crimes BNSS 2023".

The detailed curriculum is attached as **Annexure-I**.
